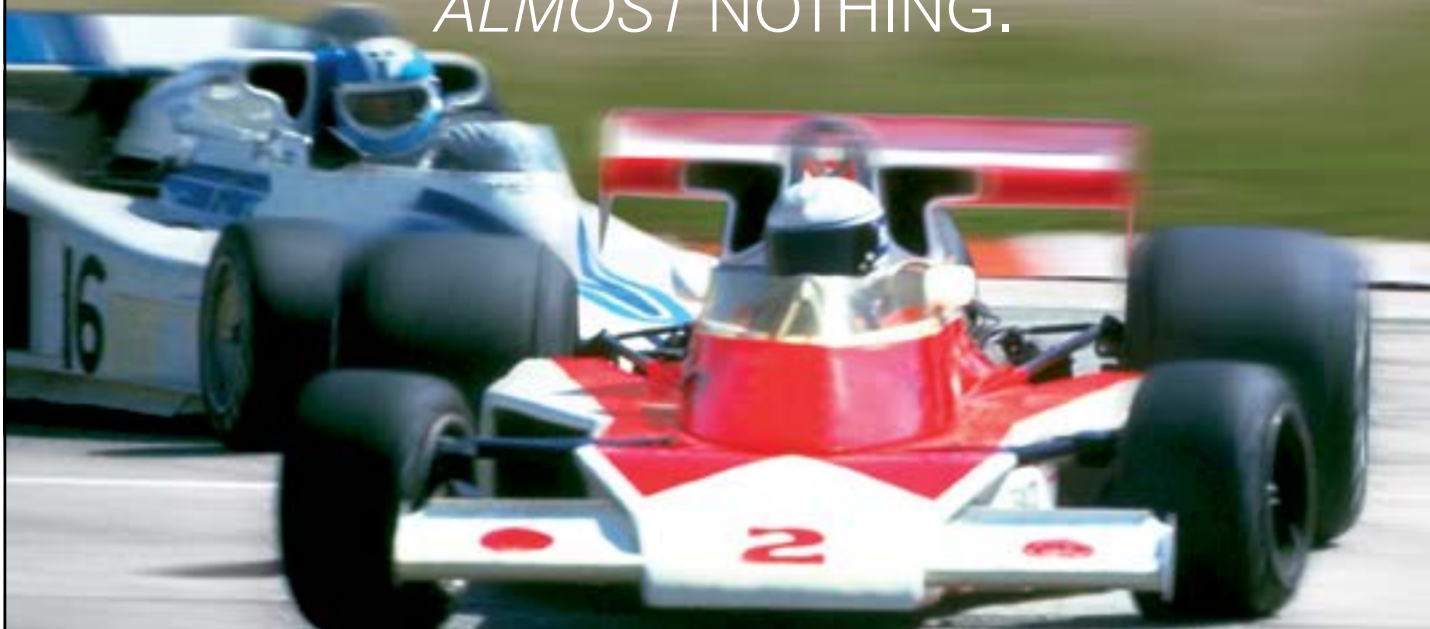

### GENERAL ROLE OF POSITION:

Provide Inspection, Quality Assurance, and Quality Control services in assigned areas to maintain plant equipment in a safe, environmentally sound, mechanically reliable and profitable condition with the objective of managing maintenance costs and optimizing capacity utilization.

### MAJOR ACTIVITIES AND PRINCIPAL RESPONSIBILITIES:

- o Actively participate in safety programs, lead safety meetings, and use safe work habits while performing the job
- o Be responsible for the Equipment Inspection PM Program in the assigned units including setting intervals, physical inspections, testing, repair recommendations, and documentation
- o Utilize and/or interpret results of non-destructive testing techniques to evaluate condition of equipment
- o With necessary technical assistance, provide input for equipment fabrication, repair, and materials selection issues
- o Utilize corrosion test racks and other on-stream techniques to monitor corrosion rates of equipment
- o With necessary technical assistance, perform incident investigation on equipment failures; determine cause, recommend corrective action, and document
- o Be a resource for and actively participate in meetings with Unit Support Teams, Turnaround Execution Teams, and problem solving teams in assigned areas
- o Provide necessary feedback for completion of Predicted Repair & Replacement of Plant Equipment for inclusion in plant expense budget.

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

- o Minimum of 5 years Maintenance craft or related experience
- o High school education or equivalent
- o Prior inspection experience and certifications
- o Working knowledge of computer programs, including Microsoft applications (Outlook, Word, Excel, etc.)
- o Proficient with the computerized PM inspection program
- o Ability to effectively communicate through written and verbal correspondence.
